



IMPORTANT NOTICE, PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

Federal law allows you, the consumer, to choose how SW DinehNet and its affiliates use your Customer Proprietary Network Information (CPNI). CPNI is data that is not publicly available, such as the type of service you subscribe to, the number of telephone lines you have, and how much you use your services.

The federal law is designed to protect you while allowing SW DinehNet and its affiliates to meet your communications needs. Protecting your privacy is our main concern.

We may share CPNI information with other companies in the course of providing your current service, and it may also be used to inform you of future products and service offerings. This allows us greater ability to tailor the services we provide to you.

You have the right, under federal law, to keep your CPNI records private by "opting out". Unless you provide SW DinehNet and its affiliates written notice or email us at optout@swctel.com within 30 days of receiving this notice, we will assume that you give SW DinehNet and its affiliates the right to share your CPNI with authorized companies. **You always retain the right to restrict the use of your CPNI.** Restriction of the use of your CPNI will remain valid until you contact us in writing or for two years, whichever comes first.

If you decide not to let us use your CPNI records, this will not affect, in any manner, the services to which you subscribe. Regardless of your decision, we will provide another notice about your rights in one year. We thank you for your time and attention to this important matter.

If you responded to this notice in December 2007 you do not need to respond unless you are changing your designation.
